

Port Gamble Bay Cleanup CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Recent Activities:

Pope Resources/Olympic Property Group received the necessary permits and approvals on June 24, and selected a contractor for the one week Pile Removal Pilot Demonstration. On June 23 the Request for Proposals on the larger Port Gamble Bay Cleanup Project was issued to prequalified contractors. The Pile Removal Pilot Demonstration will begin on Monday, June 29. Up to 50 creosote pilings adjacent to the Port Gamble mill site will be removed during low tides. This one week pilot project will provide information on techniques for removing different types and ages of creosote piling in Port Gamble Bay, as many of the pilings are very old and may be difficult to remove. During the week of June 29 – July 3, the Port Gamble mill site will have limited public access due to piling removal activities. However, kayak rentals will continue to operate from the western beach of the Port Gamble mill site.
